# WINGHAVEN JUNIOR GOLF

The mission of the WingHaven Junior Golf Program is to provide a healthy, competitive program enabling our members' children to grow both physically and mentally. We shall provide them with proper guidance and instruction so they may develop knowledge of the game of golf, a sense of appreciation for the tradition of the game and an understanding of its etiquette.

Our goal is to give them the opportunity to compete and test themselves while developing golf and life skills. The program will help each young player develop a passion for the game while making friendships for a lifetime.

The Junior Golf Programs are open to children/grandchildren of any member of WingHaven Country Club. A Junior Golfer must be between the ages of 3 and 18, having not yet attended college. The child/grandchild must be 6 years of age by June 1 to attend any program other than Little Spikes. Age requirements for the PGA Junior League teams will vary depending on the program.

The Summer Junior Golf Program is divided into a **Developmental Division** – 3 Hole, 5 Hole Blue (Short), 5 Hole Gold (Long), and 5 Hole Yellow (Extra Long) along with a **Competitive Division** – 9 Hole Novice, 9 Hole, and 18 Hole. These groups are defined by age and ability. The Junior Golfer will progress through the program in accordance with their abilities. All advancements are determined by the Golf Professionals based on their assessment of each participant according to the parameters set forth in this handbook. Each golfer is monitored, and their progress is tracked throughout the season. Maturity and etiquette are also important considerations prior to advancement.

The WingHaven Junior Golf Program will feature numerous programs offered during the Spring, Summer and Fall Seasons. We look forward to having your junior golfer(s) active from the Junior Golf Kickoff Event in April through the end of September.

# LITTLE SPIKES AGES 3 – 5

The Little Spikes program offers golfers ages 3 – 5 an opportunity to be introduced to the game through basic instruction and golf games. A parent or grandparent MUST accompany each child during the session. The program includes four (4) sessions and includes instruction from PGA professionals, a Little Spikes golf shirt, ice cream at each clinic and an opportunity to begin their golf careers! Cost is \$95 per child.

## SUMMER DEVELOPMENTAL DIVISION AGES 6 AND OLDER

**3** HOLE GROUP (AGES 6-8) The 3 hole group will play 3 holes approximately 150 yards in length. They play on designated Tuesday evenings during the season. A Parent/Guardian must accompany each junior. If a Golfer scores 21 or less during the target score play or if they reach their 8th birthday, they may be moved up to the 5 Hole Blue Group. Golfers may not move up to the 5 Hole group until July provided they have recorded the required score in June.

\*Parents may assist their juniors in carrying their golf bags – 3 Hole ONLY. In order for a 3 Hole golfer to move up to 5 Holes, the junior golfer must be able to carry his/her own clubs by themselves.

#### 5 Hole Blue Group (Ages 8 and Older)

The 5 hole Blue Group will play 5 holes approximately 150 yards in length. It is recommended that they be at least 8 years of age and demonstrate a level of maturity, etiquette and ability. They play on designated Tuesday evenings during the season. Each junior must be accompanied by a Parent/Guardian. If a golfer in this group should score under 35 for two consecutive weeks, they will be moved up to the 5 Hole Gold Group. If they should score above 55 for two consecutive weeks, then appropriate placement needs to be discussed with the Golf Professionals. Age & endurance level will be a considering factor for placement.

## 5 Hole Gold Group (Ages 8 and Older)

The 5 hole Gold Group will play 5 holes approximately 200 yards in length. They play on designated Tuesday evenings during the season. Each junior must be accompanied by a Parent/Guardian. If a golfer in this group should score under 35 for two consecutive weeks, the Golf Professionals will consider moving them up to the 5 Hole Yellow Group. If they should score above 55 for two consecutive weeks, they may be moved back to the 5 Hole Blue Group

## 5 Hole Yellow Group (Ages 8 and Older)

The 5 hole Yellow Group will play 5 holes from the yellow tees at the beginning of the fairway. They play on designated Tuesday evenings during the season. Each junior must be accompanied by a Parent/Guardian. If a golfer in this group should score under 35 for two consecutive weeks, the Golf Professionals will consider moving them up to the 9 Hole Novice Group. Age, maturity, endurance level, and completing the WingHaven "Junior Golf Bag Tag Test" will be considering factors for placement. They will not be automatically moved to 9 Hole Novice. If they should score above 55 for two consecutive weeks, they may be moved back to the 5 Hole Gold Group

#### Cost of Summer Development Division:

\$180 for Full Golf Members and \$200 for Social Members includes 6 weeks of playing opportunities on Tuesdays, 6 weeks of instruction on Thursday mornings, junior golf shirt, gift, awards, and the Putting Championship.

## 2022 3 HOLE SCHEDULE

The 3 Hole program is geared for golfers ages 6 - 8. This program will consist of Tuesdays on the golf course with tee times between 5:10 and 7:00 pm that parents may book one week in advance by emailing your tee time and pairing request to <u>juniorgolf@winghavencc.com</u>. Thursdays feature instruction at the practice facility in the instruction time slot that you select -9:00 am or 11:00 am.

## 2022 5 HOLE SCHEDULE

The 5 Hole program is geared for golfers ages 8 and older. Depending on ability, the junior golfer may play from either the Blue (short), the Gold (long) or the Yellow (extra long) junior tees. This program will consist of Tuesdays on the golf course with tee times between 3:00 and 5:00 pm that parents may book one week in advance by emailing your tee time and pairing request to juniorgolf@winghavencc.com. Thursdays feature instruction at the practice facility in the instruction time slot that you select – 10:00 am or 12:00 pm.

# SUMMER COMPETITIVE DIVISION AGES 13 AND OLDER

## WINGHAVEN GOLF COURSE ACCESS

\*\* New in 2022 – The 9 and 18 Hole Programs On-Course Play Day moves to Thursday mornings!

Junior golfers under the age of 13 are required to have adult supervision on the golf course or professional approval to play without a parent. For those junior golfers ages 13 and older, you must have an adult be with you while you play OR have successfully passed the WingHaven Bag Tag Test. In order to join the 9 Hole Novice, 9 Hole, or 18 Hole Group, you must earn a WingHaven Junior Golf Bag Tag every year. This bag tag is earned by passing the junior golf rules and etiquette test, demonstrating a level of maturity, etiquette and ability to play on the golf course at or under the allotted time without the supervision of an adult. This bag tag can be taken away due to poor etiquette or sportsmanship at WingHaven CC. This will be determined by the Golf Professionals.

The 9 Hole and 18 Hole group members may record your scores into the Handicap GHIN System. As a junior golfer, you can receive a \$10 GHIN handicap through MAGA. Ask the Golf Shop to register you for this service.

#### 9 Hole Novice Group

The 9 hole novice group will play from designated yellow tee markers located near the beginning of each fairway. If the boy golfer shoots 50 or lower, girl golfer shoots 60 or lower for 2 consecutive weeks and has golf professional approval, they will be moved to the 9 Hole Group. If they should score 70 or above and are unable to play in 2 ¼ hours or less appropriate placement needs to be discussed with the golf professional staff.

#### 9 Hole Group

The 9 hole group will play from the red tees. If the boy golfer shoots 50 or lower, girl golfer shoots 60 or lower for 2 consecutive weeks and has golf professional approval, they will be moved to the 18 Hole Group. If they should score 70 or above and are unable to play in 2  $\frac{1}{4}$  hours or less they may be moved back to the 9 Hole Novice Group.

#### 18 Hole Group

The 18 hole group will play 18 holes, with boys playing from the red, white, or blue tees and girls playing from the red tees. Age, skill and driver distance will determine which tees to play. If they should score 120 or above for two consecutive weeks and can't play in 4  $\frac{1}{2}$  hours or less, they may be moved to a shorter tee or moved back to the 9 Hole Group.

On Tuesdays, junior golfers may select which instruction time will work best for them. Space is limited in each group. Topics of lessons will include pre-swing fundamentals, full swing and short game techniques, course management along with rules and etiquette.
